Enclosed you will receive a certificate, No. 28157, for \$134.66 payable to you as father of deceased or to your order, by any paymaster of the U. S. Army, being for pay due Johothan Wells, a late Corpl. in Captain Wolff Company G, 98th. Regiment of N.Y.Vols. for services from the first day of March 1862, when last paid, to the 20th. day of Maych, 1862, time of his death and the \$100 Bounty allowed per Act. July 2nd., 1861.
