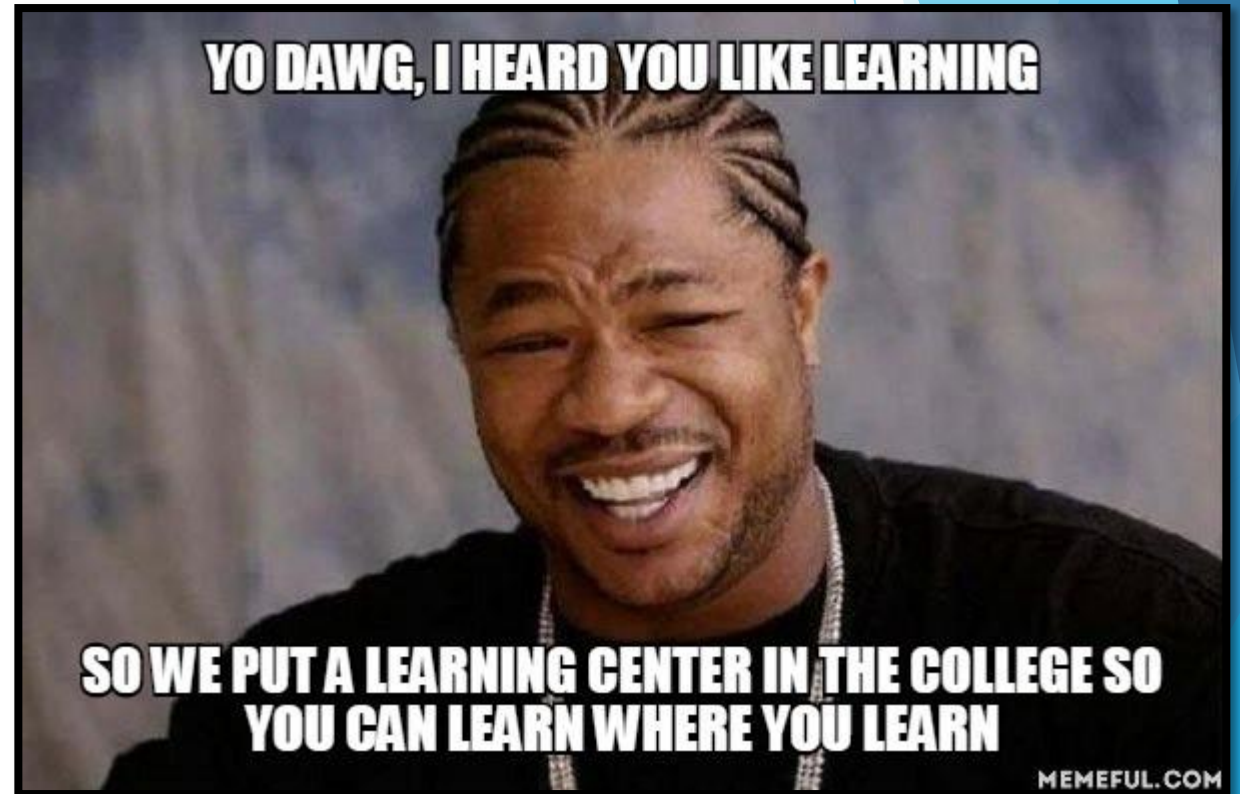

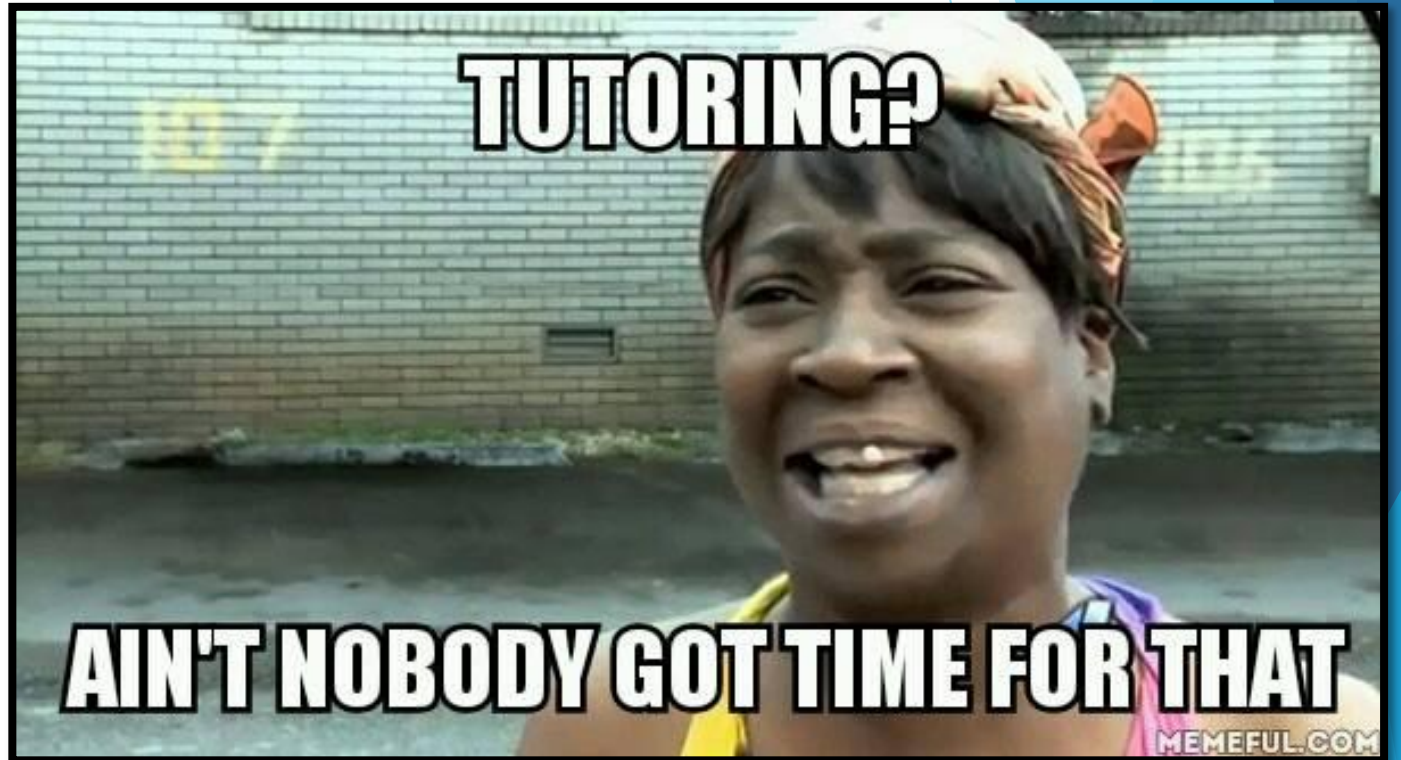
There is a schedule you know...

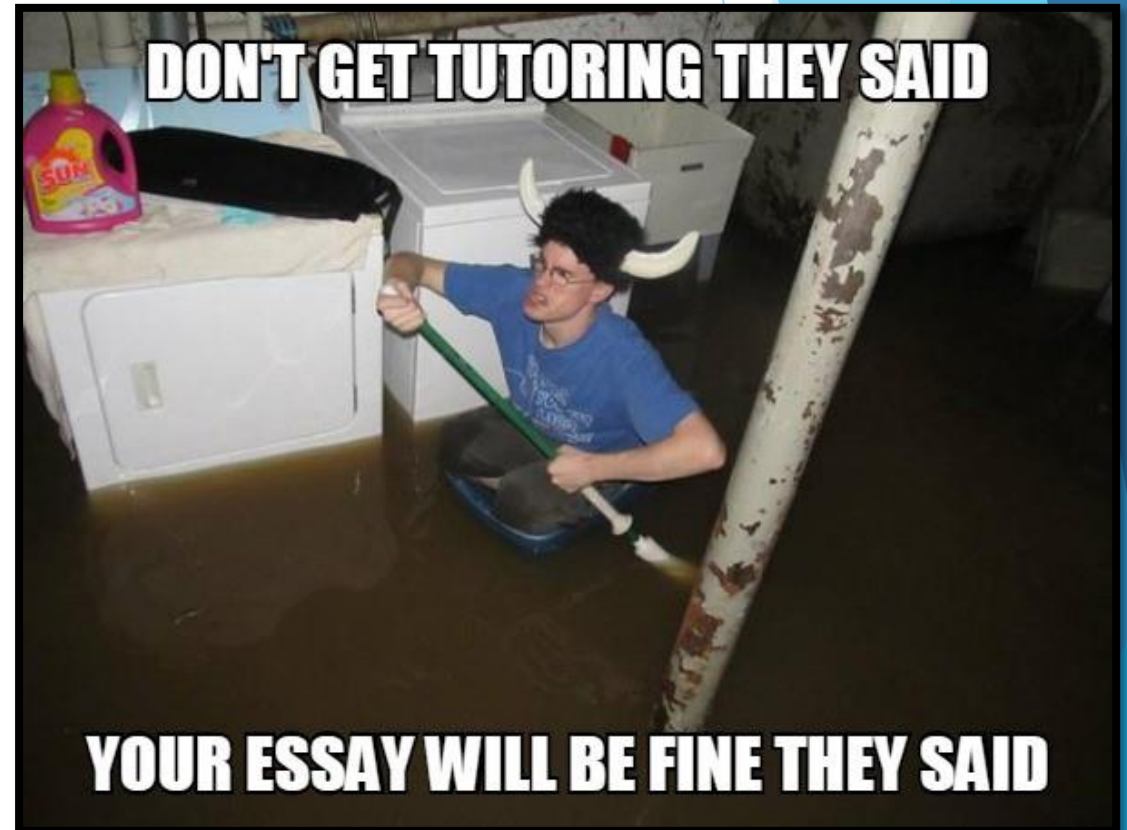
But it's very flexible

Actually... contrary to popular belief, tutoring usually takes as much time as the tutee feels they need, especially during walk-in sessions. You can be in and out as soon as you want to!



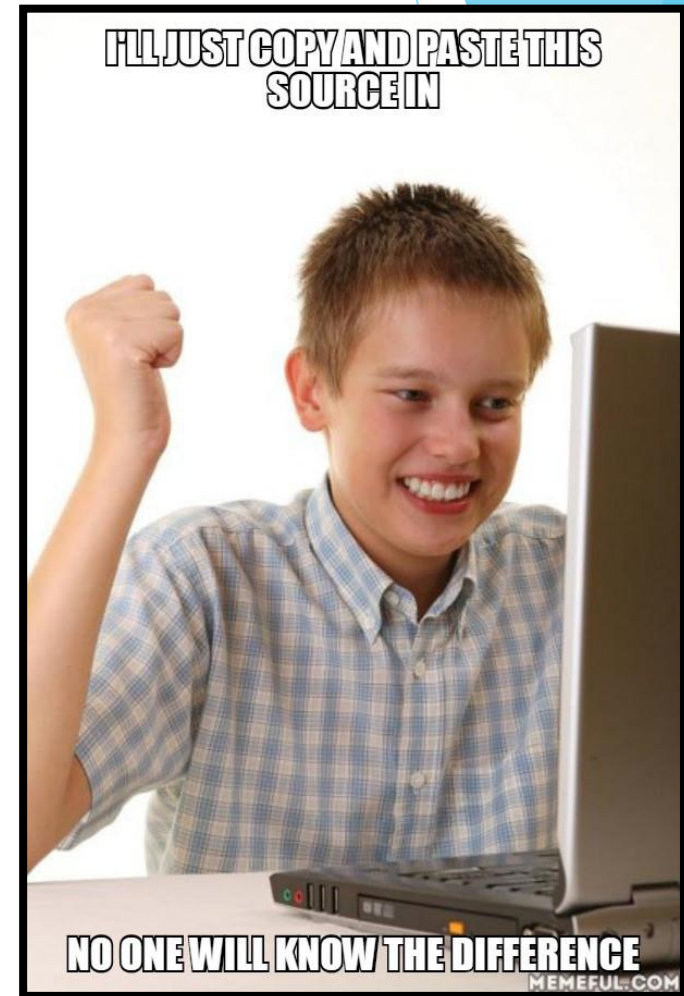
Don't think it's just ok

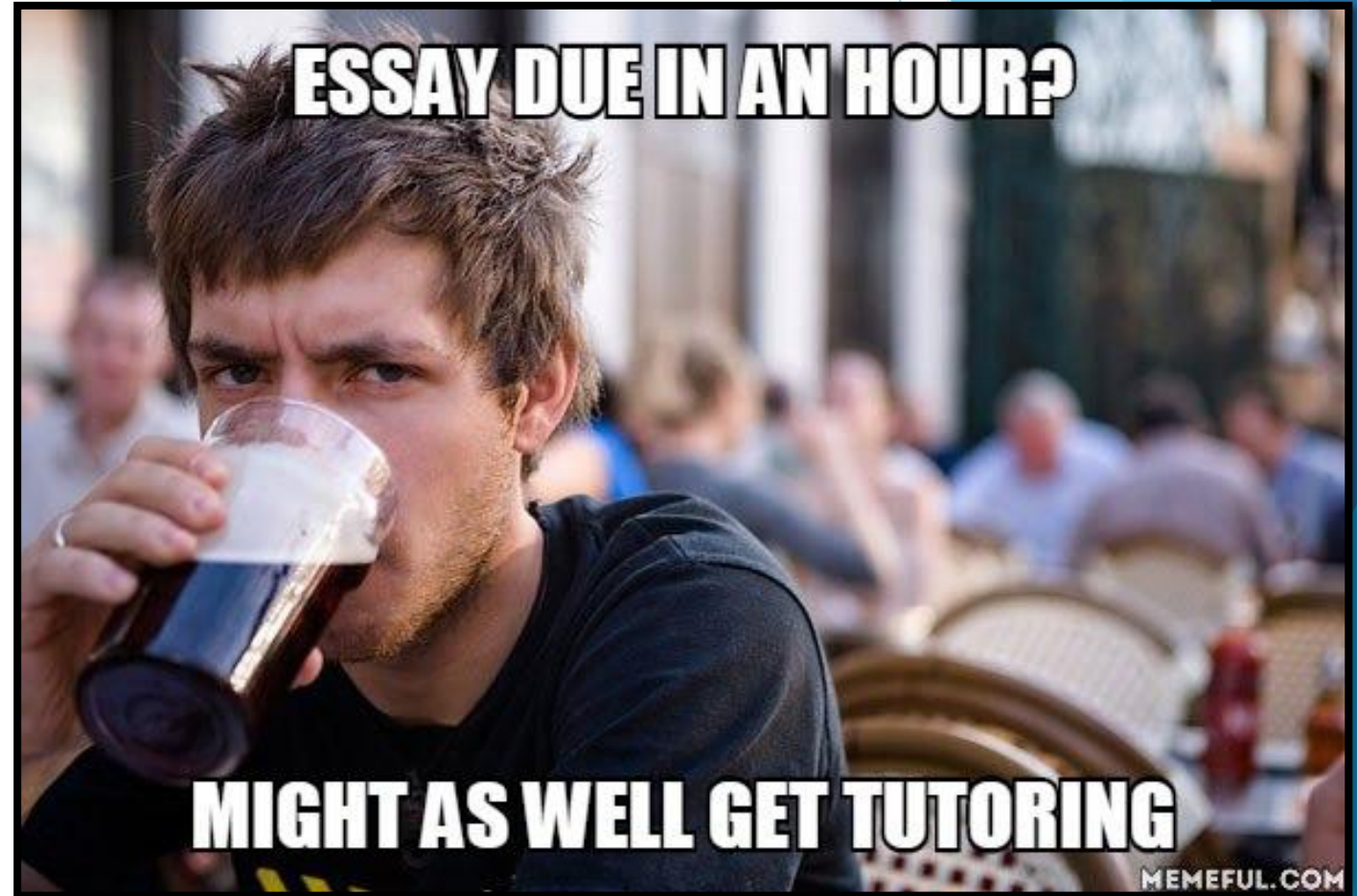
We can help find the minor, sometimes fatal flaws

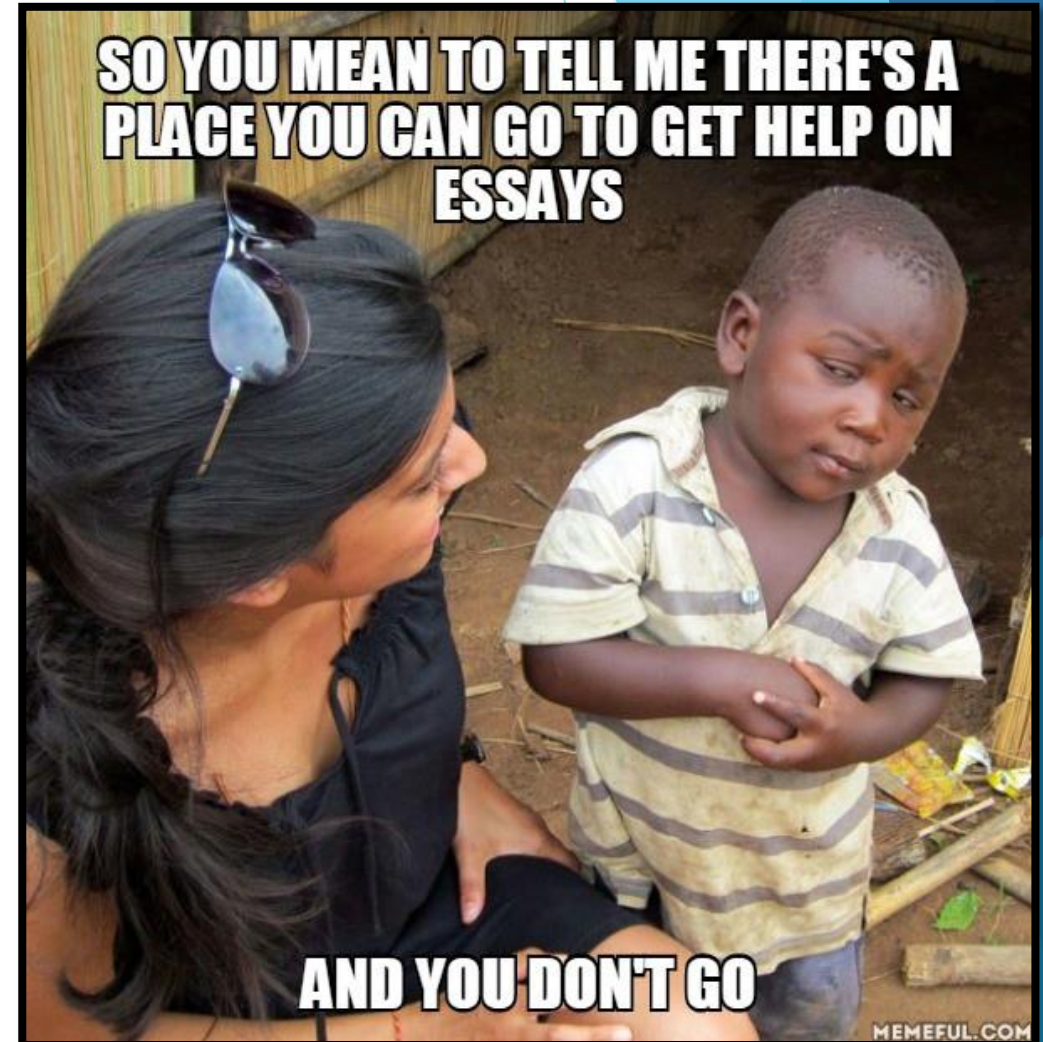
Don't be a lazy college senior

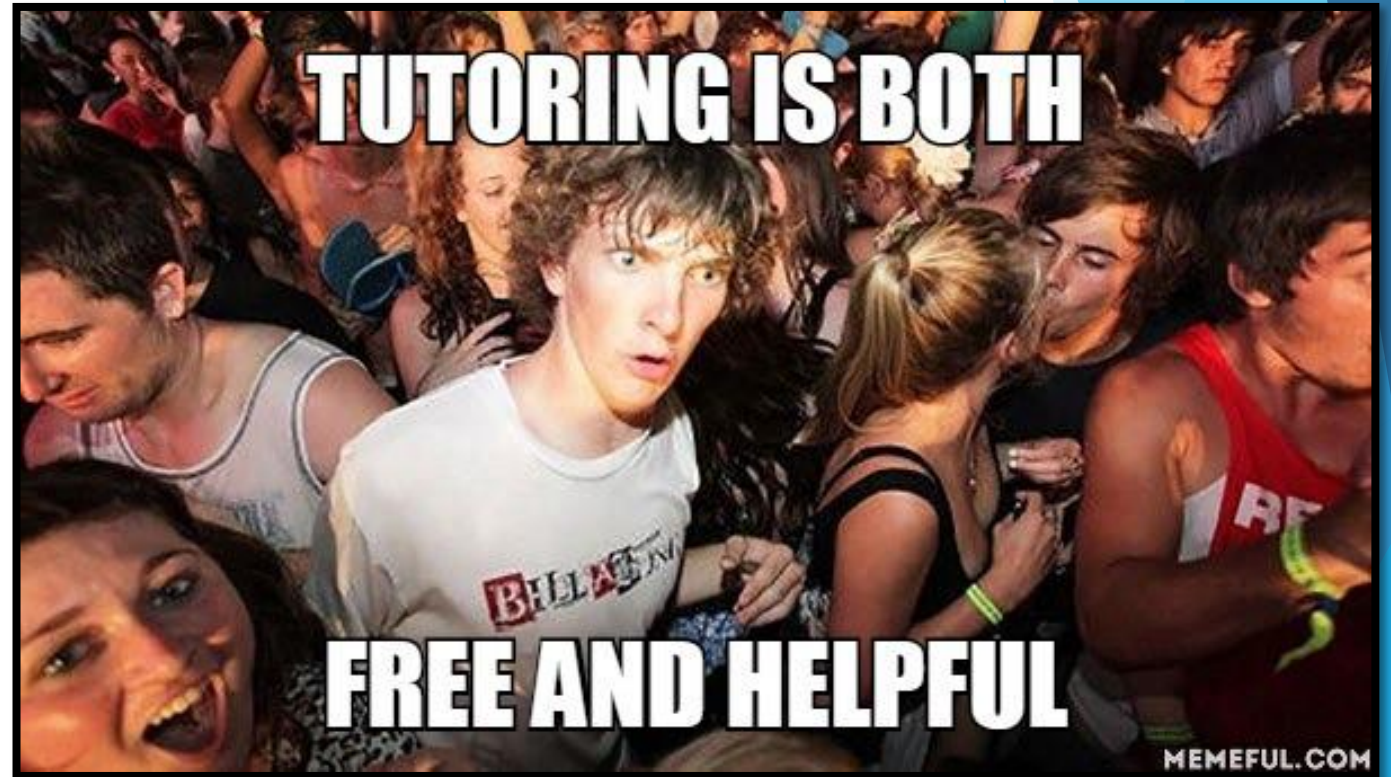
Unfortunately, not enough people know about tutoring

Unfortunately, many people don't go get tutoring, despite how much they actually need it. The help is free and focused on the specific needs of the tutee, but people don't come in for it.



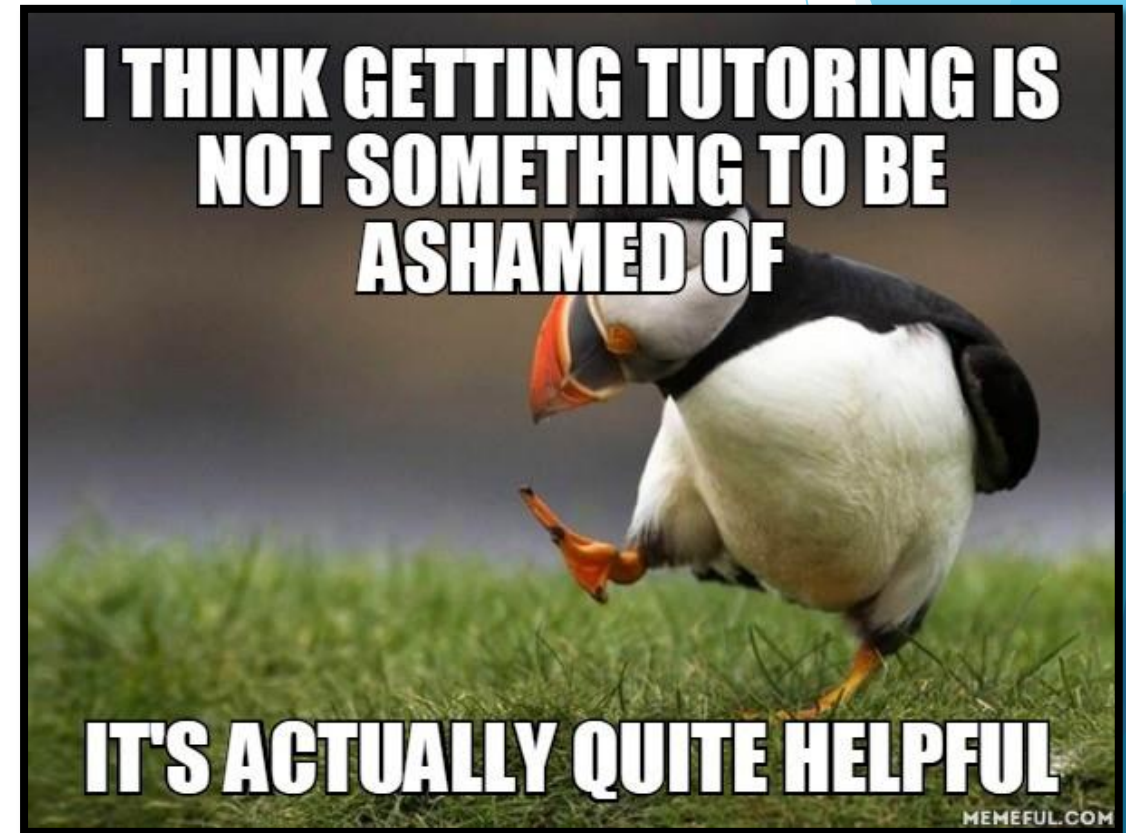
If it's all about the Benjamins...

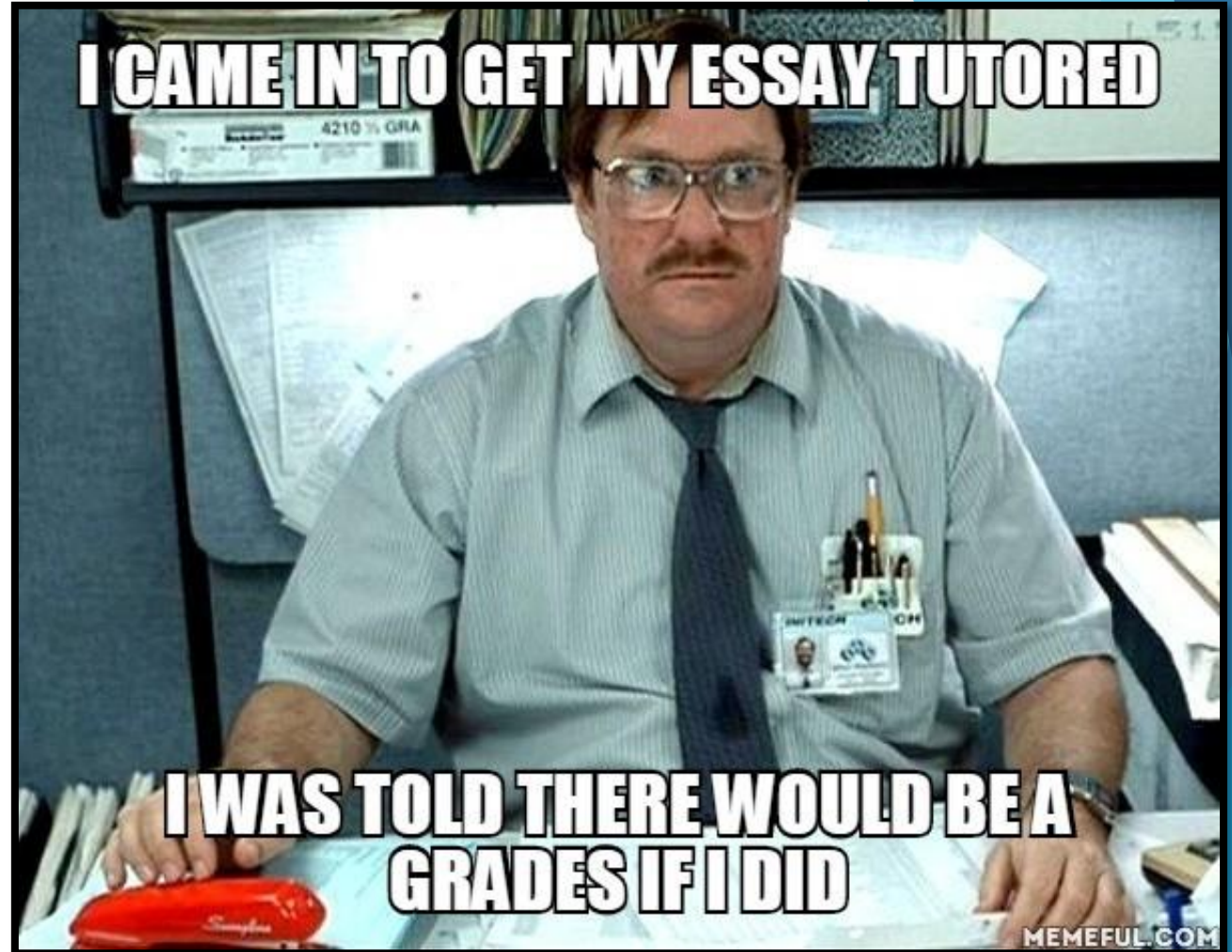
Unfortunately, it's stigmatized
